Flush toilet. When water level in tank is low, drop tablet in [tank near sidewall closest to float and away from water valve opening] [right rear corner of the tank]. When tablet has dissolved, replace with a new tablet. Each tablet sanitizes for 7 weeks.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in original container in areas inaccessible to small children in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area. Do not store at elevated temperatures. Discard empty container in trash.
