- Page 1; Added the specific individual Tablet weight.



PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Dantobrom TBS-2 is a new form of brominating hydantoin for toilet bowls. When used as directed, Dantobrom TBS-2 will sanitize toilet bowl water, keeping it clean, clear and free of odor. Dantobrom TBS-2 gives the effectiveness of chlorine without the chlorine odor. Dantobrom TBS-2 sanitizes toilet bowl water by killing 99.9% of all germs within one minute after each flush. Each tablet sanitizes for two months. Eliminates 99.9% of germs within one minute after each flush.

Tablets should be used in toilets that are flushed (daily) (regularly).
