a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 6836-283".

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- b. Revise the Environmental Hazards Statement to begin exactly as follows:
 "This product is highly toxic to birds, fish and aquatic invertebrates."
- c. Your product has been classified as toxicity category I for Acute Inhalation. Due to this classification, revise the word "POISON" to appear in red on a background of a distinctly contrasting color.
- d. Add the following language to the "Precautionary Statements": "...Fatal if inhaled. Do not breath vapor. Wear a respirator with an organic vapor removing cartridge with a prefilter approved for pesticides (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-23C), or a canister approved for pesticides (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-14G), or a NIOSH approved respirator with an organic vapor (OV) cartridge or canister with any N, R, P or HE prefilter. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin..."
- e. Delete the following statements from the "Precautionary Statements" as these are incorrect for a product which has been classified as Toxicity Category I for Acute Inhalation: "If a spill or accidental release of this product occurs, all personnel involved in cleaning up a spill or released material must wear a dust/mist filtering respirator (MSHA/NIOSH) approval number prefix TC21C." These statements do not refer to the correct type of respirator, nor is a respirator only worn when a spill or accidental release occurs.
- f. The statement: "Note: This product can only be used to formulate or repackage in a closed system." may be deleted from your label as this language is not required by the Agency.
- g. Reorder the "First Aid" statements to be begin with the most toxic routes of exposure followed by the least as per PR Notice 2001-1. Begin this section with the "If on Skin or clothing" followed by "If in Eyes" with the third and fourth sections as "If Inhaled" and "If Swallowed".

Add the following language for "If Inhaled:

- Move person to fresh air.
- If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice."

h. Revise the "Pesticide Storage" section to include the following:
 "Pesticide Storage: Store upright in original container and place in locked storage area..."

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3. Upon completion, submit a one year Storage Stability and Corrosion Characteristics Study as well as an Enforcement Analytical Method to the Agency for review.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
