Since this product's use sites include residential swimming pools, and it is unlikely that homeowners have access to respirators, this product label will not be required to include the respirator precautionary language. However, the label must state that the product may be fatal if inhaled. Therefore, the 2nd sentence in the "Precautionary Statements" must be revised to read "May be fatal if swallowed or inhaled."

Please Note: The Agency is currently working on a policy that addresses the concerns regarding products that are classified in category II for acute inhalation and used in residential areas. You will be required to make the appropriate changes to the label once the policy has been completed.

- d. Since this product is toxicity category I for primary eye and skin irritation as well as, a "Note to the Physician" section must be added to the label after the "First Aid" statements. It should read "NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probably mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage."

SWIMMING POOLS AND OUTDOOR SPAS

Barquat 50-65B P&S should be added along pool edges while filter and pump are in operation. To provide time for even distribution in the pool water, bathers should wait a minimum of 15 minutes after Barquat 50-65B P&S addition before entering the pool.

For pools and spas with visible algae, add 14 fluid ounces of Barquat 50-65B P&S for every 10,000 gallons of water (5 ppm active quaternary). After 24 hours, remove dead algae by cleaning. If algae is still present, repeat dosage as necessary.

For initial treatment of clean pools and spas, add 5 to 8 fluid ounces of Barquat 50-65B P&S for every 10,000 gallons of water (2 to 3 ppm active quaternary). Maintenance additions of 2 to 3 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons (0.5 to 1 ppm active quaternary) should be added every 7 days, or more frequently depending on water and use factors.
