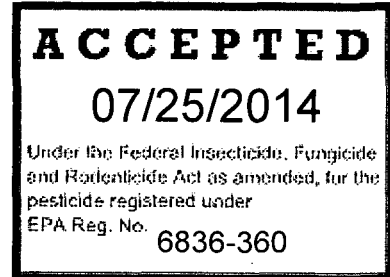

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use 5.0 fluid oz.[10 tablespoons] **BIO-GENTLE BacSoft 6** per 100 lbs. of fabric [dry weight]. Use a maximum of 60 gallons [500 lbs.] of water per 100 lbs. of fabric [dry weight].

To soften laundered fabrics and obtain residual bacteriostatic activity against gram negative and / or gram positive odor- causing bacteria, dilute the appropriate amount of **BIO-GENTLE BacSoft 6** in one to two gallons of water and then add to the wash-wheel at the beginning of the final rinse cycle.

Repeat the treatment of fabric with **BIO-GENTLE BacSoft 6** after each washing.
