Vantocil® P – Lonza Microbiocide is for the manufacture of: swimming pool sanitizers and disinfectants for use in commercial, industrial, and residential settings. Vantocil® P – Lonza Microbiocide may be used to formulate sanitizers and disinfectants for use in food handling/storage establishments, premises and equipment, including food contact surfaces in public eating places, dairy processing equipment, and food processing equipment and utensils. Repackers or reformulators must obtain their own registrations with EPA.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Open dumping is prohibited. Keep container closed when not in use. Store in a dry, well-ventilated area away from heat and open flames

Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning. If not available, puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse as follows: Fill the container ¼ full with water. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Follow Pesticide Disposal instructions for rinsate disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning. If not available, puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill.

{For Totes/IBCs} Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Clean container promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Fill container ¼ full with water and reclose the container. Agitate vigorously, and dispose of rinsate consistent with pesticide disposal instructions. Repeat two more times. Then offer for recycling if available or puncture and dispose in sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities. Follow pesticide disposal instructions for rinsate. If not triple rinsed, these containers are acute hazardous wastes and must be disposed in accordance with local, state, and federal regulations.
