AOAC METHOD


..... 5 s. typhosa s. aureus - 7.5 DIRECTIONS: Do not use with other cleaners. Mint Cleaner, Deodorizer and Disinfectant contains its own powerful cleaners. GARBAGE CANS, LAVATORIES. URINALS, FLOORS: Use at least 5 ozs. per gallon of warm water for non-porous surfaces or at least 10 ozs. per gallon of warm water for porous or difficult to clean surfaces. Let solution remain on the surface for several minutes for best results. TO CONTROL MOLD ON WALLS, CEILINGS, ETC.: Clean thoroughly with 10 ozs. per gallon of water leaving some of the solution on the surface. RESTAURANT AND BAR UTENSILS: Use at least 2.5 ozs. per gallon of water, to scrub counters and equipment. As a sanitizing rinse for eating utensils, use at least 2.5 ozs. per gallon water, run through final rinse with potable water, then let air dry. FOR ROUTINE CLEANING AND SANITIZING: Mop with a solution of 2-3 ozs. per gallon of water, wetting surface thoroughly and allowing solution to act for a few minutes, then rinse.
