

USE PRECAUTIONS

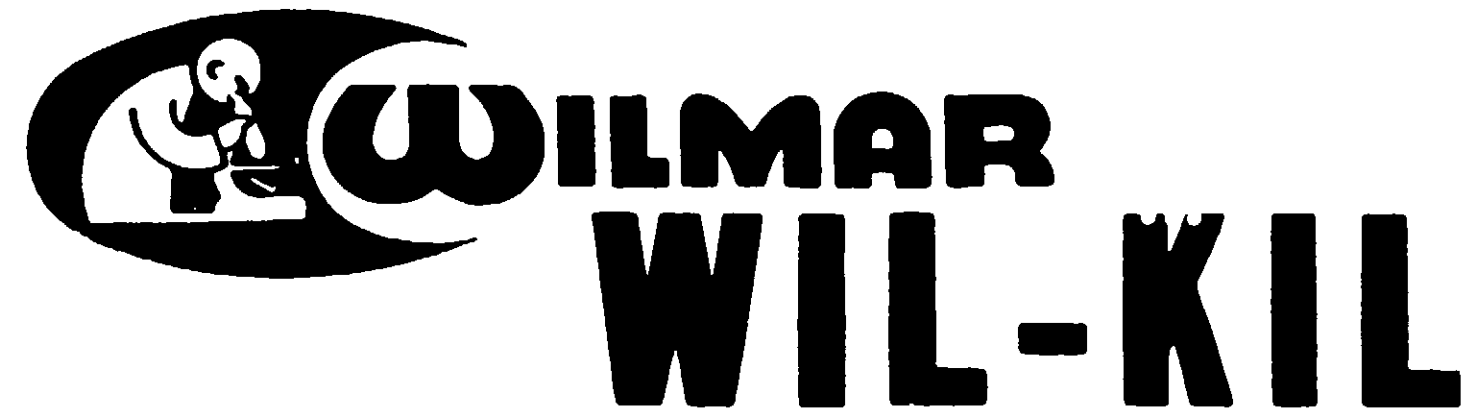

DIRECTIONS

Apply any time of year except when the ground is frozen. Best results are obtained after predominant species are well established in late spring or early summer. Before treating, calibrate equipment to insure uniform cover of the area to be treated, measure out the proper amount and apply. Coarse sprays are less likely to drift.

This weed killer is a ready-to-use solution designed to be applied undiluted as a spray on non-cropland areas where bare ground is desired. The degree of weed control and duration of effect will vary with the amount of product used, soil type, rainfall, and other conditions.

EQUIPMENT: Power sprayers, compressed air hand sprayers, knapsack sprayers or an ordinary sprinkler can be used to apply. No dilution or agitation is required.

GENERAL WEED CONTROL: To control most weeds for an extended period of time on non-cropland areas such as parking lots, fence rows, loading ramps, and railroad sidings, storage yards, around buildings and industrial plant sites, apply 1 to 5 gallons per 1,000 sq. ft. (treated 40 to 200 gallons per acre). To control annual weeds and grasses such as foxtail, ryegrass, wild oats, crabgrass, cheatgrass, ragweed, lambsquarter and turkey mullein, apply 1 to 2 gallons per 1,000 sq. ft. (40 to 80 gallons per acre).

For control of perennial weeds and grasses such as Johnsongrass, saltgrass, bouncing bet, bracken fern and broom sedge, and horsetail, apply 2 to 4 gallons per 1000 sq. ft. (80 to 160 gallons per acre). For hard to kill perennial weeds and grasses apply 3 to 5 gallons per 1000 sq. ft. (120 to 200 gallons per acre)."
