

DIRECTIONS FOR CLEANING:

Lightly soiled areas — Surfaces to be cleaned should be mopped or brushed with a solution containing 1 ounce DDC per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned area with potable water prior to reuse.

Heavily soiled areas — Mop or brush soiled surfaces with a solution containing 2-3 ounces DDC per gallon of water. Drain well.

DEODORIZATION:

To deodorize surfaces during cleaning, mop or brush surfaces with a solution containing 2 ounces of DDC per gallon of water. DDC is an effective antibacterial cleaner designed for use in industrial and institutional cleaning. When used as directed, DDC will disinfect hard surfaces such as floors, walls, counter tops and furniture. It may be relied upon to deodorize bathroom areas, garbage pails, kennel areas and other areas where obnoxious odors may develop. This product may be used as a general purpose antibacterial/antifungal detergent in schools, hospitals, nursing homes, public rest rooms and in other places where efficient cleaning and antimicrobial action is desired.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

- 1. PROHIBITIONS** — Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.
 - 2. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL** — Pesticide, spray mixture or residue that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides away from water supplies.
 - 3. CONTAINER DISPOSAL** — Triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers.
 - 4. GENERAL** — Consult Federal, State, or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited open burning.
- Container Disposal: When empty, rinse container thoroughly with water and destroy it by crushing.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To disinfect walls, floors and other hard surfaces in schools, restaurants, rest rooms and other public areas, mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 1 ounce DDC per gallon of water. Surfaces that are heavily soiled should be cleaned with 1-2 ounces DDC per gallon of water. To disinfect locker rooms, shower stalls, walkways around pools and other areas against pathogenic fungi, mop area with a solution containing 3/4 ounce DDC in one gallon of water. This solution will destroy Trichophyton interdigitale, a causative agent of athlete's foot.

HOSPITAL DISINFECTION:

To disinfect walls, floors, furniture and other hard surfaces in hospitals and nursing homes, mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 2 ounces DDC per gallon of water. Those surfaces that are heavily soiled with blood, fecal material or exudates should be thoroughly scrubbed with a solution containing 2 ounces of DDC per gallon of water, allow to soak for 10 minutes and then rinse with a fresh solution containing 2 ounces of DDC per gallon of water before disinfection. Drain well.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:

EYES: If eyes are contacted, irrigate eyes for 15 minutes with water. If discomfort persists, seek medical attention.

SKIN: If skin is contacted, wash with water. If discomfort persists, seek medical attention.

INHALATION: If discomfort is experienced after prolonged exposure to mists/vapors, remove to fresh air.

INGESTION: If ingested, give plenty of water and induce vomiting. Then give moderate amounts of water to wash out mouth area and to dilute remaining residue.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.
