

Disintex is a one-step disinfectant cleaner that is effective against a broad spectrum of bacteria, is virucidal, fungicidal, and will prevent the growth of mold and mildew and their odors when used as directed.

Disintex is an effective one-step sanitizer-cleaner for use on non-food contact surfaces.

When used as directed, Disintex will deodorize surfaces in toilet areas, behind and under sinks and counters, garbage cans and garbage storage areas, and other places where bacterial growth can cause mal odors.

**Statement of Practical Treatment**

**GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Disintex is a proven one-step disinfectant-cleaner-sanitizer-fungicide-mildewstat-virucide which is effective in water up to 400 ppm hardness in the presence of 5% serum contamination.

Apply Disintex to walls, floors and other hard (non-porous) surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, sinks, tile, porcelain and bedframes, with a cloth, mop or mechanical spray device so as to thoroughly wet surfaces. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

**Disinfection:** To disinfect hard non-porous surfaces, add 0.5 oz. per gallon of water. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. The activity of Disintex has been evaluated in the presence of 5% serum and 400 ppm hard water by the AOAC use dilution test and found to be effective against a broad spectrum of gram negative and gram positive organisms as represented by:

- Pseudomonas aeruginosa
- Staphylococcus aureus
- Salmonella choleraesuis
- Escherichia coli
- Streptococcus pyogenes
- Klebsiella pneumoniae
- Enterobacter aerogenes
- Salmonella typhimurium
- Streptococcus faecalis
- Shigella dysenteriae
- Brexitia typhimurium
- Salmonella typhi
- Serratia marcescens

**Fungicidal Performance**

Disintex is an effective fungicide against Trichophyton, Trichopytes (mold), and other fungi when used on surfaces in areas such as locker rooms, dressing rooms, showers, and bath areas, health facilities, etc. at 0.5 oz. per gallon.

**Mold and Mildew Control:** At 0.5 oz. per gallon, Disintex will effectively prevent the growth of mold and mildew on hard non-porous surfaces.

**Virucidal Performance:** Disintex is effective against a broad spectrum of viruses.

**Sanitizing Non-Food Contact Surfaces:** such as walls, tables, etc.
