The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with the Label Improvement Program Notice for Antimicrobial Products Used as Food Contact Surface Sanitizers, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. Delete the statement "Only For Sale To, Use, and Storage by Servicepersons."
 - b. Delete the words "or buried in a safe place," and "bury in a safe place."
 - c. Delete "General Classification."
 - d. Delete all sanitization claims.
 - e. Revise the referral statement to read:

See side panel for additional precautionary statements.
 - f. The Pesticide Disposal section must be revised in accordance with PR Notice 83-3.
 - g. Delete the word "milk."
 - h. Delete the entire "Note to Physician" section. This section is not required for this product.


2. Submit five (5) copies of final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed, drink  egg whites gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public water unless in accordance with an NPDES permit.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

1. PROHIBITIONS

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

2. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide spray mixture or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically processed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

3. CONTAINER DISPOSAL

a) Reuse container and offer for reconditioning, or
b) Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in approved landfill, or bury in a safe place.

4. GENERAL

Consult Federal, State and Local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE - GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

POWERCID^e detergent-disinfectant has been designed specifically for hospitals, offices, motels, nursing homes, schools, food processing plants and other institutions. 

DISINFECTION: To disinfect hard inanimate surfaces (such as walls, floors, table tops) apply solution with mop, cloth, sponge or mechanical sprayer so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes and then let air dry.

DILUTION RATES: General Disinfection - add 4.5 ounces of POWERCID^e per gallon of water. Hospital Disinfection - add 6 ounces of POWERCID^e per gallon of water.

To disinfect toilet bowls, flush toilet, add 4.5 ounces of POWERCID^e detergent-disinfectant directly to the bowl water. Swab the bowl completely using a scrub brush or toilet mop, making sure to get under the rim. Let stand for 10 minutes and flush. For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required.  Prepare a fresh solution for each use.
