DIRECTIONS

FOR MAXIMUM EFFECTIVENESS:

1. Fog only after sunset in the evening, during the night, and before sunrise in the morning.
2. Wind velocity should not be over 3-4 miles per hour.
3. Area to be fogged should always be downwind from fogging unit.

The insecticide covered by this label is specifically formulated for outdoor fogging use in the Dyna-Fog thermal fog generators and other thermal fog machines and should not be used for general spray purposes.

READY TO USE—no dilution required.

CAUTION:

Harmful if swallowed. Contact with skin can cause toxic symptoms. Avoid breathing spray mist. In case of contact with skin, wash with soap and water.

IMPORTANT

For mosquitoes and similar small flying insect, allow ample fogging time for each area so that fog remains in area a minimum of 10 seconds.

For flies and similar larger insects, ample fogging time must be allowed so that fog remains in area a minimum of 40 to 50 seconds.

General outdoor fogging should be carried out only on the surface in which the insects which are being controlled exist only for one hour after sunset through the night, and until sunrise during this time, or during the time that the wind velocity is under 4 miles per hour. Fogging will remain on the ground and cover the ground the required time for effective control of insects. Fogging is not recommended for use in areas where the fog particles are likely to be inhaled or ingested.
