Do not use formula M 50 in mist spraye or mist foggers in mushroom growing houses as a residue may result causing burning of the mushrooms.

For the control of <u>flying insects</u> fog at the rate of l oz. for each 4000 cu. ft. of space. Direct fog away from tables and equipment.
