DILL

HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES, AND GNATS

Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward, direct the spray mist to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist. Then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room after treatment is complete.

WASPS

Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray thoroughly on the hiding and breeding places contacted, as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

CRAWLING INSECTS

Roaches, earwigs, crickets, firebugs, sowbugs, spiders and centipedes spray throughout the building. Plants such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, especially around pipes and leaks, under refrigerators, baseboards and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible.

ANTS

Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.
