Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Replace "EPA Reg. No. 6911-3" with the correct new number "EPA Reg. No. 6911-5". b. On both the front panel and the back panel, which appears to be a front panel minus the ingredients statement, the entire product name "NU-MRK NU-METHOD ANT & ROACH KILLER should appear together on the label. Delete "Made by Professionals", all products made for sale to produce income are made by definition made by professionals, therefor the term serves

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only to be potentially misleading, especially given its close proximity to the product name, which could be interpreted as claiming professional-use or a special professional status for what is meant to be a household use product. Likewise, replace "FOR GENERAL USE" with "FOR HOUSEHOLD USE" [Note - quotation marks appearing around text in this Notice should not appear on your printed label]. Delete "NEW IMPROVED" from the front panel. This is a replacement registration for the same product that has been sold since 1982. Delete "Fully Effective" from the product name band. You may, however, add "Effective" above the claim "Quick Acting". The term "Long Lasting" should be expanded to indicate how many days or weeks your efficacy data shows the product remains effective.

- c. Make the following changes to the ingredients statement: delete "100%" after "Active Ingredients", and add the heading "Inert Ingredients" (in the same size type and in the same alignment as "Active Ingredients" above "petroleum distillates").
- d. In the Directions For Use, delete "etc." after "stoves".
- e. Revise the Heading "DISPOSAL" to read "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" and add as the first sentence under this heading "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal." Then add the next two sentences that currently appear on your label, i.e., "Do not reuse empty containers. Wrap containers in newspaper and put in trash collection."
- f. In the HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS text, revise the first sentence to read "Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Add "or pets" between "Do not allow children" and "in treated areas until surfaces are dry." (likewise make the same revision in that stand alone sentence at the bottom of the side panel. After "... as a spot treatment only." add "Do not spray electrical conduits, outlets, motor housings, or electrical switch boxes." Replace "Ventilate areas to be sprayed." with "Apply only in well-ventilated areas." After "Do not use on household pets or humans." add "Do not apply where children are likely to frequently contact treated surfaces."
- g. In the Statement of Practical Treatment, add If inhaled advice to read "Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Get medical attention." Add "Get medical attention." to the end of the If on skin advice. Revise the If in eyes advice to read "Flush eyes with plenty of

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water. Call a physician immediately.".

h. Directly under the Statement of Practical Treatment add:

Note to Physician: If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal any may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine. Petroleum solvent presents aspiration hazard.

i. At the bottom of the side panel, add the heading "PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS" above "CAUTION: FLAMMABLE MIXTURE".

j. Please consider using the back panel to present the directions for use and the precautions (especially since there will now be even more text) in larger type size rather than just compressing all that information onto the side panels and rather than having the back panel virtually the same as the front as on your current submission.

k. Be sure to meet type size requirements for elements of the label with minimum type size requirements.

3. The Diazinon Registration Standard requires that you must identify on the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) form the levels present of four toxicologically significant impurities, TEPP, OS-TEPP, SS-TEPP, and Oxo-diazinon, which are present in your product from the starting diazinon material you use when making your product. This information must be submitted to the Agency as soon as possible, but no later than 3 months from the date of registration of your product. Rather than your company conducting this chemical analysis, you may immediately contact your supplier (telephone Ms. Carol Oddi at 212-661-9800) to request that they directly submit to the Agency (and preferably also to you for your records) their calculated values for those impurities based on the percentage of their product you use when making your product. Together with the these four impurities and their levels in your product (just give the maximum possible level in the Upper Certified Limit column 14a of the CSF form) you must add the following two signed statements at the end of your CSF form:

I hereby certify that, for the purposes of FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(C), the description of the composition of NU-MARK NU-METHOD ANT & ROACH KILLER, EPA Reg. No. 6911-5, refers to the composition set forth in this Statement of Formula and supporting materials. This description includes the

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representation that (1) no ingredient will be present in the product in an amount greater than the upper certified limit or in an amount less than the lower certified limit specified for that ingredient in this Statement of Formula; and (2) If the Agency requires that the source of supply of an ingredient be specified, that all quantities of such ingredient will be obtained from the source specified in the Statement of Formula.

I certify that the upper certified limits for the impurities listed on this Statement of Formula or supporting materials are based on Makhteshim-Agan of North America, Inc.'s analysis and certification of limits for this product based on their technical Diazol/Diazinon - 8 lbs. Per Gal. Oil Concentrate, EPA Reg. No. 11678-20. I further certify under Section 61-3 and 61-2(b) that there are no chemical reactions between diazinon and/or any of its impurities with the intentionally added inerts.

No. 6911-3 will be relabeled with this new label, including all revisions indicated in this Notice of Registration, prior to release for shipment.
5. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

CAUTION

If in eyes — Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician immediately.
