- e. Add a statement that each formulator is responsible for obtaining EPA registration for their end-use products.
- f. Everywhere it appears on the labeling change the Signal Word from CAUTION to WARNING. On page 8, the Guidance for the Reregistration of Pesticide Products containing Thiram states the Agency will consider registration of technical grade products containing thiram for acute toxicity category II, providing those products bear appropriate precautionary statements. Refer to the Proposed Labeling Requirements published in the FEDERAL REGISTER on September 26, 1984. If toxicity category II is inappropriate for this product, submit or cite the appropriate acute toxicity studies.

3. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
