The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
  - a. Delete the word "treatment" and add "Statement of Practical Treatment."
  - b. Add the Misuse statement under the "Directions for Use" heading.
  - c. Delete the phrase "Only For Sale To, Use And Storage By Service Persons."
3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.



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**TREATMENT**

**IF IN EYES:** Flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician.

**IF ON SKIN:** Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

**IF SWALLOWED: DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING.** Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

**INSTITUTIONAL APPLICATIONS**

**DISHES, GLASSES AND UTENSILS**

1. Scrape and pre-wash utensils and glasses whenever possible.
2. Wash in appropriate Merit detergent.
3. Rinse in clean water.
4. Sanitize (by immersion, flooding or spraying) using IODIBAC at a concentration of 1 ounce to 10 gallons of hot water (12½ ppm) for a period of 2 minutes.
5. Drain properly. Air dry — DO NOT TOWEL.

**NOTE:** If final rinse tanks are lined, clean them thoroughly with PH-5 before starting the IODIBAC program.

**FOOD SERVICE EQUIPMENT**

1. Clean slicers, mixers, grinders, etc., thoroughly with compatible Merit detergent.
2. Rinse in clean water.
3. Sanitize (by using immersion, flooding or spraying) with a solution of 1 ounce of IODIBAC to 10 gallons of hot water (12½ ppm). All equipment and surfaces should be exposed to the sanitizer for a period of not less than 2 minutes.
4. Drain properly. Air dry — DO NOT TOWEL.

**USE DILUTIONS**

- 50 ppm  
2 oz. to 5 gallons water
  - .25 ppm  
1 oz. IODIBAC to 5 gallons water
  - 12½ ppm  
1 oz. IODIBAC to 10 gallons water
- Used solution may not be re-used for sanitizing but may be used as a detergent.

### EQUIPMENT TO UTENSILS

1. Rinse with warm water.
2. Wash with IODIBAC, 1 oz. to 10 gallons warm water.
3. Rinse with warm water.
4. Immediately prior to use, sanitize (by immersion, flooding or spraying) for 2 minutes with IODIBAC using 1 oz. to 5 gallons of water. Drain and air dry.

### MOLD CONTROL

1. Wash surfaces with 2 oz. IODIBAC to 5 gallons of warm water (120°F).
2. Spray or rinse with 50 ppm solution of IODIBAC. Drain and air dry.

### DANGER CAUSES SKIN IRRITATION

Use in recommended strength. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of exposure, flush skin or eyes with a copious quantity of water, get medical attention. Avoid contamination.

### UDDER WASHING AND SANITIZING

1. For each cow to be milked, place one clean towel in container with fresh warm 25 ppm IODIBAC solution.
2. Wash udder and teats, then discard towel in second container.
3. After milking, dip each teat in dip cup containing 25 ppm IODIBAC.
