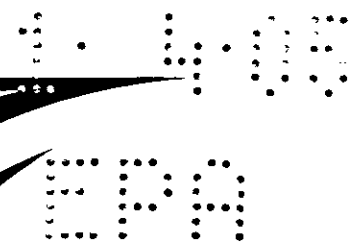

Use Kork Rub to clean, disinfect, and deodorize;

- Walls
- Telephone
- Sinktops
- Restrooms
- Food Preparation Areas
- Garbage Pails

When used as directed, Kork Rub cleans, disinfects, and prevents bacterial odors and kills pathogenic fungi *Trichophyton mentagrophytes*.

Directions for Use

General Disinfection: Hold spray bottle 6-8" away from surface. Thoroughly wet surfaces. Allow surfaces to remain wet for 10 minutes. Allow surfaces to air dry or remove excess liquid with clean cloth, mop or sponge. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required. Prepare a fresh solution daily or more often if it becomes visibly soiled or dirty.

Fungicidal: Pre-clean before disinfecting. To disinfect hard nonporous surfaces in locker rooms, shower and bath areas against the pathogenic fungi, *Trichophyton mentagrophytes* (Agent cause of Athletes Foot Fungus), saturate surfaces. Allow surfaces to remain wet for 10 minutes, then air dry.

Food Preparation Areas: Before using this product, food products and packaging materials must be removed or carefully protected. Use on floors, walls, tables, (you may use on additional hard nonporous surfaces). Follow disinfection directions. Rinse food contact surfaces with potable water. Do not use this product on glasses, dishes, or utensils.

Precautionary Statement Hazardous to Humans and Domestic Animals

Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing spray mist. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear safety glasses or goggles. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If in eyes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes • Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advise
If on skin or clothing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take off contaminated clothing • Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advise
If swallowed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advise • Sip a glass of water if able to swallow • Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor • Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
If inhaled	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move to fresh air • If the person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration. • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advise
