before your ship product:

The proposed revised label for this product is generally acceptable, but one important organizational change must be made. Center the main heading "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" in the left side panel of the label and delete the colon (:) which now follows it. This change is needed so that it is clear to people who read the label that the instructions on how to use the product legin with the main heading "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" and not with "APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:" which, as a subheading, must remain left-justified on the left side panel as must the other subheadings to the "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" (i.e., "READ THIS LABEL:", "IMPORTANT:", "USE RESTRICTIONS:", "SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS"). As revised, the "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" should be organized as shown below.
