DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. Apply when plant is not in operation.

In hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for two hours after spraying. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, FRUIT FLIES: Close doors and windows. Pointing nozzle upward direct the aerosol spray to all parts of the room especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. 2 to 4 seconds application per 1,000 cubic feet space is usually sufficient. To prevent staining, hold nozzle at least 3 feet from fabrics. Keep room closed 15 minutes after each treatment. When used as a space spray, leave the treated area. Ventilate room when treatment is completed.

WASPS: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

FOR CRAWLING INSECTS: ROACHES, EARWIGS, GRAIN MITE, SOWBUGS, SPIDERS and CENTIPEDES: spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards, and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL BEDBUGS AND LICE: Apply as a spot treatment to cracks and crevices around baseboards, floorboards, bedboards, and walls. First, thoroughly clean and air mattresses and springs. Then spot treat only areas that may harbor pests, concentrating on tufts, folds and seams. Repeat as necessary. For persistent infestations, consult professional applicator.
