Subject: Labeling Amendment Submitted in Response
to PR Notice 87-6
EPA Registration No. 6950-54

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the following comments.

- 1. Add the following Statement of Practical Treatment.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

If Inhaled: Remove to fresh air.

If On Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and water. Wash contaminated clothing separately from other laundry. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If In Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Note To Physician: Contains petroleum distillate.
Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

- 2. Add the following precautionary statement to the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section, "In hospitals, patients should be removed from room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for two hours after spraying. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation."
