FLYING INSECTS: Files, Sandilles, Mosquitoss, Gnats, Wasps, Small Flying Moths, Fruit Files, Indian Meal Moths, Almond Moths, Foreign Grain Beattles.

Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Press. valve down and spray as directed. To avoid possible staining of fabrics or surfaces, do not spray at close rance.

Calculate the cubic feet of the area to be treated. Close all doors and windows.
