GENERAL INFORMATION: Crawling Insect Killer provides effective control of pests in and on buildings and structures and their immediate surroundings and on modes of transport. Permitted areas of use include, apartment buildings, homes, hotels, hospitals, nursing homes, schools, industrial buildings, laboratories, mausoleums, private residences, utilities, and in non-food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, and on: vessels, rail cars, buses, trucks and trailers. Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. In the home cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils or wash thoroughly after treatment. For use in non-food areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). FIRST AID

apart. In long running cracks, move the injector tip along the crack while spraying. Move at the rate of one linear foot per second in heavy infestations and three feet per second in light infestation. See the additional directions below for effective control of specified insects. Crawling Insect Killer may be used as a crack and crevice treatment or as a spot application in non-food/feed areas. All areas where insects hide or through which insects may enter should be treated.

COCKROACHES (including adult and immature stages of both non-resistant and organophosphate and carbamate resistant strains), ANTS, BOOKLICE, BOXELDER BUGS, CRICKETS, DERMESTIDS, FIREBRATS, FLEAS, SILVERFISH, TICKS AND SOWBUGS: Apply as a spot or crack and crevice treatment. Apply to areas where these pests crawl and hide, especially in hidden areas around sinks and storage areas, behind baseboards, around doors and windows, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks and stoves, the underside of shelves, drawers, bookcases and in similar areas.

ANTS: Spray ant trail in and around doors and windows and other places where ants enter premises, around nests hidden under steps, brickwork, concrete, etc. Break apart accessible nests and spray on and around debris.

CARPENTER ANTS: For effective control, locate and treat nests and surrounding areas. Apply around doors and windows and other places where ants enter premises and where they crawl and hide. Inject into wall voids and infested wood through existing openings or newly drilled small holes.

BROWN DOG TICKS AND FLEAS IN BUILDINGS: Remove pets prior to treatment. Apply to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, under the edges of rugs and floor coverings, between and under cushions of upholstered furniture and other areas where these pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. Do not apply directly on animals or humans, or apply to animal feed or watering equipment. For best results, pets should be treated with appropriate flea and/or tick control product registered for use on pets. Allow spray to dry prior to reentry of treatment area.

SPIDERS: Apply along and behind baseboards, to window and door frames, corners, pipes, storage localities, attics, crawl spaces and other areas over which these pests may crawl.

CENIPEDES, EARWIGS, GROUND BEETLES, MILLIPEDES, MOLE CRICKETS, PILLBUGS, SOWBUGS, SCORPIONS AND TICKS: Apply around doors and windows and other places where these pests may enter premises. Treat baseboards, storage areas and other locations where these pests are found.

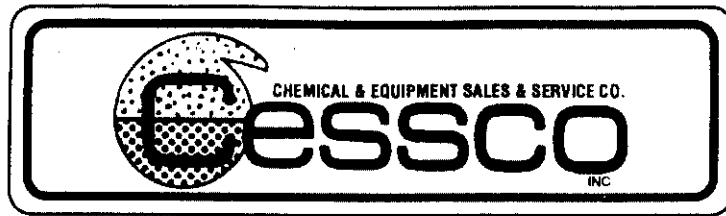
PANTRY PESTS - GRAIN BEETLES (RUSTY, MERCHANT AND SAWTOOTHED), FLOUR BEETLES (RED AND CONFUSED), CHOCOLATE MOTHS, CIGARETTE BEETLES, CLOVER MITES, CLUSTER FLIES, DRUGSTORE BEETLES, ELMLEAF BEETLES, RICE WEEVILS, LESSER GRAIN BORERS, SPIDER BEETLES AND TOBACCO MOTHS: Treat exposed stages. Remove all foodstuffs, utensils and shelf paper from area to be treated. Discard used shelf paper and any infested foodstuffs. Apply spray to shelves and in cracks and crevices behind and under cupboards and cabinets. Allow spray to dry prior to replacement of food and utensils.

CARPET BEETLES (Black, Furniture and Varied): Spray on and under edges of floor coverings, under rugs and furniture and in closets or other localities where these insects are found.

PESTS ON OUTSIDE SURFACES OF BUILDINGS: For control of building infestation due to Ants, Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Millipedes and Sowbugs (Pillbugs). Spray foundation of building where insects are active and may find entrance up to a height of 2 to 3 feet. Apply as a residual spray to outside surfaces of buildings where insects tend to congregate. Spray areas include screens, window frames, eaves, porches, patios, garages and refuse dumps.
