

# LIMINATE!

## Swimming Pool Algaecide Concentrate

### DIRECTIONS

**INITIAL TREATMENT** (Preferably after pool has been cleaned and filled with fresh water): Pour 1 gallon of LIMINATE! for each 50,000 gallons of pool water, preferably by pouring 1 quart LIMINATE! into each corner of the pool; LIMINATE! will distribute itself through the water.

**MAINTENANCE TREATMENT:** 1 gallon of LIMINATE! to each 50,000 gallons of pool water every 4 to 5 days in warm, sunny or humid weather; 1 gallon of LIMINATE! to each 50,000 gallons of pool water every 5 to 7 days in cool or cloudy weather.

**BOOSTER TREATMENT:** After a heavy or prolonged rainfall add 1 quart LIMINATE! for each 50,000 gallons of pool water. When bathing load is excessively heavy, add 1 quart LIMINATE! for each 50,000 gallons of pool water.

### **DANGER: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.**

Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling concentrate. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

This product is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds or public water.

### FIRST AID

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

Note to physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

**HEAVY TREATMENT:** Add 4 gallons LIMINATE! (1gallon in each corner) for each 50,000 gallons of pool water, when pool closes. In the morning, vacuum precipitated algae. Add fresh water, give initial treatment and continue with preventive treatment.

Usable for Reflective Pools and Decorative Pools.

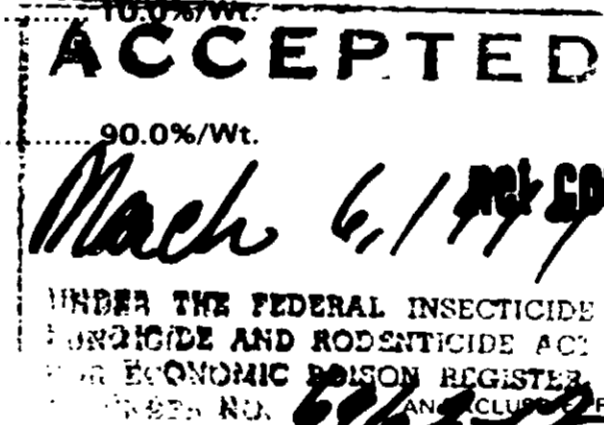
