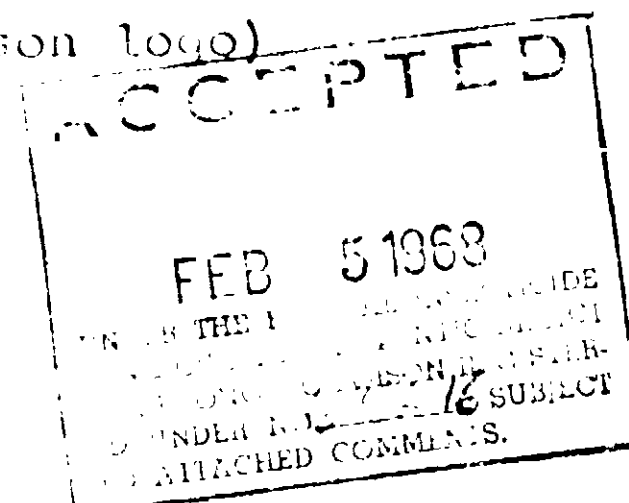


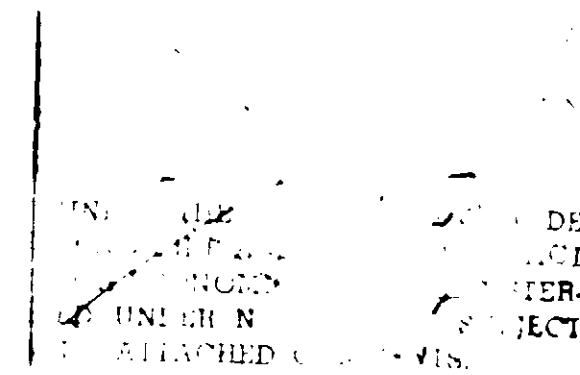

D I R E C T I O N S

CHEMPLEX should not be mixed with other
soaps, cleaners or detergents as they
can impair its active ingredients.

DISINFECTING*: Hard Surfaces - Use 2½ fl.
oz. CHEMPLEX to 1 gal. water to produce
400 parts per million active germicidal
(quaternary) solution.

Porous Surfaces, Hospital Use and Mold and
Mildew Control: Use 5 fl. oz. CHEMPLEX to
1 gal. water to produce 800 parts per
million active germicidal (quaternary)
solution.

After using CHEMPLEX on food processing
equipment and utensils rinse thoroughly
with potable water before re-use.

GENERAL CLEANING: Floors: Add 3 fl. oz.
CHEMPLEX to 1 gal. warm water. Walls -
add 2 fl. oz. CHEMPLEX to 1 gal. warm water
