### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:

#### Special Instructions for improved performance:

- Slugs and snails favor dark, damp places. Bait where these pests stay during daylight hours.
- Be sure area to be baited is damp. In dry weather, water area well before baiting.
- Apply bait in evening as these pests feed mainly at night.
- Until under control, bait should be renewed at least every 7-10 days or more frequently if necessary.
- Since snails and slugs migrate extensively invasions from adjacent areas are anticipated, a barrier of bait will aid in control.
