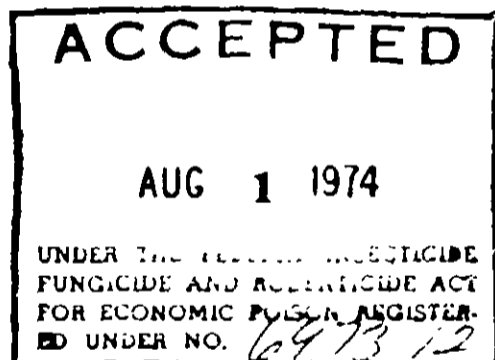

NOTE TO PHYSICIANS -- TREATMENT: 1-100, 2 or 3 tablets immediately as required or until pupils dilate. Do morphine. Clear chest or postural drainage. If patient becomes comatose. Observe patient for respiratory depression. Response to cholinesterase inhibitor medication to small doses of any cholinesterase inhibitor should be allowed until blood cholinesterase activity returns to normal.

WARNING AND PRECAUTIONS DURING USE: Do not use in areas occupied by unprotected humans. Wear rubber gloves, protective clothing and eye protection. Replace gloves frequently. 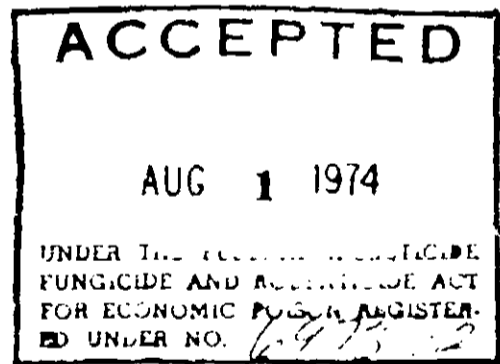

NOTE TO PHYSICIANS - TREATMENT Give atropine, preferably by injection, 1-2 grains, 1-100, 2 or 3 tablets, immediately and repeat parenterally or orally as required or until pupils dilate. Do not exceed a total of 30 tablets. Never give morphine. Clear chest or postural drainage and administer artificial respiration if patient becomes comatose. Observe patient carefully for 48 hours. Inasmuch as exposure to cholinesterase inhibitor may cause, without warning, prolonged disability to small doses of any cholinesterase inhibitor, no further exposure of the individual should be allowed until blood tests give ample proof of cholinesterase regeneration.

WARNING AND PRECAUTIONS DURING USE Do not apply or allow to drift in areas occupied by unprotected humans or beneficial animals. Operators should wear rubber gloves, protective clothing and effective masks certified for Phosdrin protection. Replace gloves frequently. Unprotected humans and animals should be kept out of treated areas for 24 hours following treatment. Keep Phosdrin out of reach of children and domestic animals. Decontaminate containers by washing with hot, soapy solution and destroy to prevent reuse for any purpose.
