Special instructions for improved performance are:

Slugs and snails favor dark, damp places. Bait where these pests say during daylight hours.

Be sure area to be baited in s damp. In dry weather, water area well before baiting.

 Apply bait in evening as these pests feed mainly at night.
 Until under control, bait should be renewed at least every 7-10 days or more frequently if necessary. 5. Since snails and slugs migrate extensively, when invasions from adjacent areas are anticipated, a barrier of the bait will aid in control.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a dry place. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited. Pesticide that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable federal, state or local procedures. Completely empty container by shaking, and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of container in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities. If burned, stay out of smoke. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
