DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

A specific formulation for depressing growth of bloom-producing blue-green algae in swimming pools. Best results are obtained if applied on bright, sunny days when water temperature is over 55 F. Mix Miracle-P with about 3-5 gallons of water and stir thoroughly. In pools having circulating or filtration systems, pour directly into pool, covering as much surface area as possible. In pools having no circulating system, apply solution by spray over surface. Agitate solution during spraying. Add any remaining solids to the pool.

DOSAGE:

Apply one quart of Miracle-P for each 50,000 gallons of water. Repeat this dosage at maximum intervals of one week if algae begin to reappear on the floor.

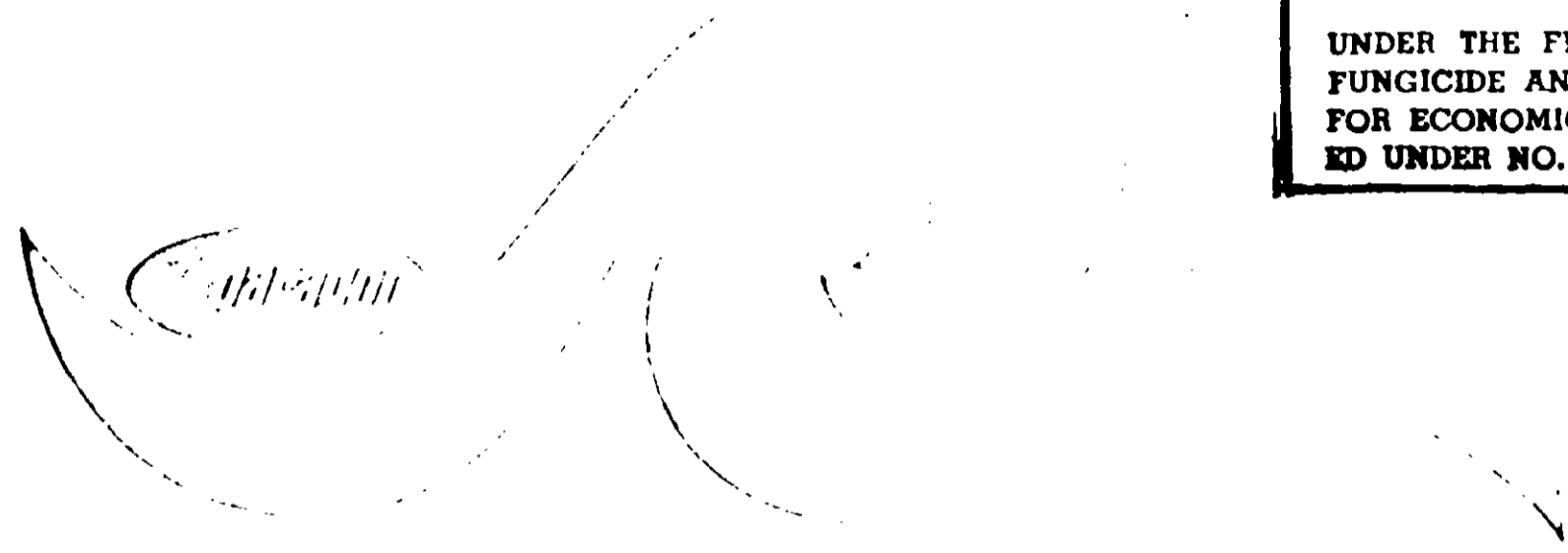
