Water 10.0% Max.

DIRECTIONS:

For maximum disinfecting and deodorizing action, apply in concentrations described below. Wet all surfaces thoroughly with mop, brush or cloth and allow to remain at least 10 minutes before rinsing.

TO DISINFECT AND DEODORIZE:

Toilet Bowls—Add 2 fl. oz. (¼ cup) undiluted to bowl. Bathrooms, Showers, Kitchen Cabinets—Add 2 fl. oz. to 1 gallon warm water. Rinse. Garbage Cans—Remove gross filth and soil deposits before wetting all surfaces. Use 2 fl. oz. per gallon of water. Rinse.

TO CLEAN AND DEODORIZE:

Laundry—Add 4 fl. oz. (½ cup) to average load during wash or rinse cycle. Follow with hot rinse. Floors, Walls, Cars—Use 2 fl. oz. per gallon of warm water. Rinse.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
