DIRECTIONS FOR USE

TO OPERATE: Remove plastic cap. Hold dispenser upright. Point away from you and press button, directing spray at plant foliage.

Hold pressurized dispenser 18 to 24 inches from plant foliage during spraying to avoid injury. Spray the plant foliage lightly but thoroughly, to wet both sides of the leaves and insects present. Repeat treatments as necessary, but do not overspray, as burning may result. Spray in sweeping motion or in short bursts. For best results, apply spray in the evening or early morning. Avoid application during heat of day or in direct sunlight. Apply weekly or until insects or diseases have been eliminated. Avoid spraying delicate new growth or sensitive plants as cyclamen, lantana or maiden hair fern.
