

## WARNING

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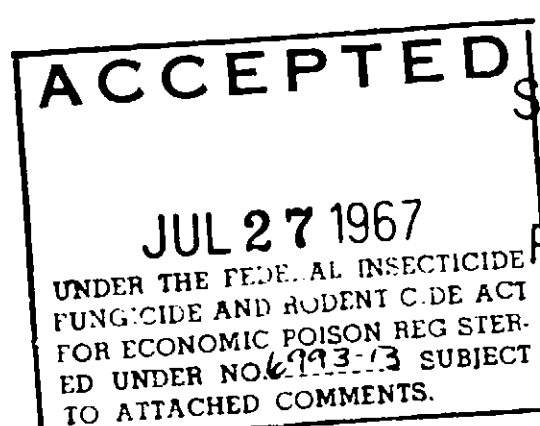

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## GERMAIN'S Non-Selective Weed Killer

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Observe all cautions and warnings in the handling of this material. Use only as directed. Read the label thoroughly before using. **Germain's Non-Selective Weed Killer** is a general herbicide with a fast-acting double killing action. It kills by contact and by root absorption. Root killing action on deep rooted perennials and some woody plants does not normally occur until rain, or applied moisture, carries the active ingredients down to the root zone.

**Germain's Non-Selective Weed Killer** is recommended for killing existing weeds and grasses, and to prevent regrowth on walks, patios, driveways, black top and gravelled areas, playgrounds, and for creating firebreaks around homes and other structures on potential brush fire areas.

**MIXING AND USING THE SPRAY.** Measure the required amount of **Germain's Non-Selective Weed Killer** directly into sprayer or sprinkling can and then add the needed quantity of water and stir vigorously. The finished spray material tends to separate on standing and it therefore should be gently agitated from time to time while it is being applied. For control of heavy brush, deep-rooted perennials, woody plants, and tall weeds: Use 1 quart of **Germain's Non-Selective Weed Killer** to 2 gallons of water and apply to 250 square feet.

For control of existing annual weeds and grasses: Use 1 quart of **Germain's Non-Selective Weed Killer** to 3 gallons of water and apply to 375 square feet.

Two days after applying **Germain's Non-Selective Weed Killer**, water the treated area deeply to increase plant absorption. One treatment normally provides a control for a full season. Repeat application if necessary. If longer lasting control is desired, use one quart of **Germain's Non-Selective Weed Killer** to 2 gallons of water and apply to 125 square feet.

**FOR SPOT TREATMENT** of woody plants such as Poison Oak, Honeysuckle, Blackberry, and Bermuda Grass outcroppings on driveways, patios, and parking lots, apply at the rate of 1 quart of **Germain's Non-Selective Weed Killer** mixed in 2 gallons of water. Spray all exposed parts of plants and saturate soil around base. Follow with deep watering. Apply with tank sprayer or with a sprinkling can.
