It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

Read entire label and apply as directed. Shake well before using.

For best results, use throughout the growing season to prevent buildup of insect populations. Spray plants from a distance of 1 1/2 to 2 feet using short bursts (one second). To prevent injury to plants, avoid visibly wetting the foliage.

Apply in the early morning or late evening when the air is still, treating all foliage with particular attention to the undersides of the leaves. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Repeat applications at 7 to 10 day intervals or after heavy rains. Do not apply to feed crops within one day of harvest.
