Chlorpyrifos is used as the insecticide. Insects controlled are Larvae of the Webworm, Chinch Bugs, Ants, Crickets, Earwigs, Sawflies, Flea Beetles, Brown Dog Tick, Cutworms, Moths, and other detrimental turf insects.

Turf Supreme plus Insecticide contains enough plant food for a regular feeding of 1 lb. of Nitrogen per 1,000 sq. ft. when applied at the rate recommended. This will assist the reestablishment of growth in damaged areas.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For best results treated area should be moist at the time of application. To release the insecticide, water thoroughly immediately after application. Apply Turf Supreme plus evenly and uniformly over the infested area. Application may be made with standard Broadcast or drop-type spreaders. Check spreader calibration prior to application.


