DIRECTIONS FOR USE

KILLS ANTS EARWIGS, LAWN MOTHS (SOD WEBWORMS), ROACHES, BEETLE GRUBS ARMYWORMS, CUTWORMS, AND SIMILAR INSECTS INFESTING LAWN AND GARDEN SOIL.

LAWN INSECTS: Japanese Beetle Grubs, White Grubs, Chafer Beetle Grubs, Armyworms, Cutworms, 1 lb. granules per 1,250 sq. ft. Water thoroughly after application. Lawn Moths, Sod Webworms, Cutworms, Armyworms, Crickets, Ants, Earwigs. Apply 1 lb. per 1,250 sq. ft. Water lightly after application.

FLOWERS AND ORNAMENTALS: Ants, Armyworms, Crickets, Sowbugs, ticks on ground and ground plants at the rate of 1 lb. per 483 sq. ft. Earwigs. Use same amount, applying to stems of ground plants and around flowers. In flower beds, apply to stems of flowers and similar areas.
