Double-D Oil
EPA Registration No. 7001-152
Your Submission Dated October 23, 1985

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- a. Whenever a common name for a pesticide chemical has been accepted as official, that name must appear in the ingredient statement followed (in parentheses) by the correct chemical name. Therefore, the submitted label requires the following form of declaration:

Diazinon [0,0-Diethyl-0-(2-isopropyl-6-methyl-4-pyrimidinyl) phosphorothioate*]

- b. Separate the child signal word from the precautionary statement. The precautionary statement is normally required on the side panel. The precautionary statement and subheading should be revised to read similar to the following:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.
- If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
- If on skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
- If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-Pam is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

- d. Delete the statement "Keep out of lakes, streams, etc. . ." and replace it with the statement, "Do not apply directly to water."

2. Add the statement "Recommended for Agricultural/Commercial Use" to the front panel.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED give victim 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with blunt object. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician.

IF INHALED remove victim to fresh air.

IF ON SKIN wash with soap and water. If irritation persists contact a physician.

IF IN EYES flush with water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not combine with sulfur sprays and do not apply spray oil within 30 days before or after application of sulfur.

Do not apply to trees weakened by disease, drought, drying winds or high nitrogen applications.

Do not apply when temperatures are above 90° F.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on crops. Protective information may be obtained from your Cooperative Agricultural Extension Service.

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Apply this product only as specified on this label. RE-ENTRY STATEMENT

Do not apply this product in such a manner as to directly or through drift expose workers or other persons. The area being treated must be vacated by unprotected persons. Do not enter treated areas without protective clothing until the spray has dried. Certain states may require more restrictive re-entry intervals for various crops treated with this product. Apply to give total coverage to all parts of the tree. Thorough drenching of the trunk, limbs, twigs is essential for maximum insect control. To be used for dormant or delayed dormant application only.

For dilute spray use spray water per acre. Concentrate 20 to 100 gallons of water

Use only in spray machine. Keep agitation running during applications. This product will not wash off constantly.

Almonds: *Parlatoria* Scale, *Borer*, *Aphid Eggs*, *Spider Eggs*, *San Jose Scale*, 100 gallons or 5 to 8 gallons per acre

Apricots, Peaches, Nectarines: *San Jose Scale*, *Spider Eggs*, *San Jose Scale*, 1 1/2 gallons per acre concentrate—do not apply within 20 days of harvest

Apples: *Apply Aphid Eggs*, *Mite*, *Mealy Bug*, *San Jose Scale*, 5 to 8 gallons per acre concentrate apply within 14 days of harvest only.

Cherries: *Black Cherry Scale*, *San Jose Scale*, 5 to 8 gallons per acre concentrate water or 5 to 8 gallons per acre concentrate harvest only.

Pears: *Mealy Bug*, *Parlatoria Scale*, *Brown Apricot Scale*, *San Jose Scale*, 100 gallons per 100 gallons per acre concentrate spray. Post harvest application.

Plums, Prunes: *Peach Scale*, *San Jose Scale*, *Parlatoria Scale*, 1 1/2 gallons per 100 gallons per acre concentrate spray. Do not apply within 20 days of harvest.
