The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
  - a. Add the following Environmental Hazards paragraph to your label. The following paragraph must be placed after your Hazards to Humans Section:

**Environmental Hazards**

This product is extremely toxic to aquatic and estuarine invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

Cotton - 7-day PHI  
Apples - 1-day PHI

 release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these  
 conditions.

### RE-ENTRY STATEMENT

Do not apply this product in such a manner as to directly or through drift expose workers or other persons. The area being treated must be vacated by unprotected person. Do not enter treated areas without protective clothing until the dust has settled. Certain states may require more restrictive reentry intervals for various crops treated with this product, consult your State Department of Agriculture for further information.

Written or oral warnings must be given to workers who are expected to be in a treated area or in an area about to be treated with this product. When oral warnings are given, warnings shall be given in a language customarily understood by workers. **Asparagus, Strawberries:** Apply 40 lbs. per acre. Do not apply within 1 day of harvest.

**Beans, Carrots, Corn, Eggplant, Okra, Peppers, Potatoes, Tomatoes, Sweet Corn:** Apply 40 lbs. per acre. No time limitation.

**Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Head Lettuce, Garden Beets (roots), Horseradish, Parsnips, Radishes, Rutabagas, Turnips (roots):** Apply 40 lbs. per acre. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest.

**Cotton:** Apply 30 to 40 lbs. per acre. No time limitation.

**Cucumbers, Squash, Melons Peanuts:** Apply 20 lbs. per acre. No time limitation.

**Sugar Beets, Collards, Endive (escarole), Garden Beets (tops), Kale, Leaf Lettuce, Parsley, Spinach, Swiss Chard, Turnips (tops):** Apply 40 lbs. per acre. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.
