PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles. In case of contact wash immediately with soap and water. Wear a respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety Administration (formerly the U.S. Bureau of Mines) and by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the provisions of 30 CFR Part 11. Keep all unprotected persons out of operating areas or vicinity where they may be in danger of drift. STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Atropine is antidotal. 2-Pam is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

ANTIDOTES: IF SWALLOWED induce vomiting by giving victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician immediately.

IF INHALED remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN immediately wash with soap and water. In case of contact with clothing remove immediately.

IF IN EYES flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

SYMPTOMS OF POISONING: Headache, nausea, vomiting, cramps, weakness, blurred vision, pin point pupils, tightness in chest, labored breathing, nervousness, sweating, watering of eyes, drooling or frothing of mouth and nose, muscle spasms and coma.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal or approved state procedures under Subtitle C of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

Completely empty bag by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of bags in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Artichokes: Aphids, Armyworms (to 3rd instar), Plant Bugs. Apply 2 pounds per acre. **Artichoke Plume Moth, Cutworms, Cabbage Looper.** Apply 4 pounds per acre. If plants are out in April and May, begin applications after September and repeat at 14 to 21 day intervals as needed through December. Apply at 30 day intervals in January and February followed by 14 day intervals from March through the end of picking season. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Collards, Kale, Kohlrabi, Mustard Greens: Aphids, Armyworms, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers, Mites. Apply 4 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 21 days of harvest.

Celery: Aphids, Armyworms, Cabbage Looper. Apply 4 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 15 days of harvest.

Lettuce: Aphids, Armyworms, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers, Mites. Apply 2 1/2 to 4 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 21 days of harvest.

Peas, Peppers: Aphids, Armyworms (to 3rd instar), Cabbage Looper. Apply 4 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 15 days of harvest.

Rutabagas: Aphids, Armyworms. Apply 4 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 21 days of harvest.

Spinach: Aphids, Leafhoppers, Mites. Apply 2 1/2 to 4 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 21 days of harvest.

Tomatoes: Aphids, Armyworms, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers, Cabbage Looper, Mites. Apply 4 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 15 days of harvest.
