HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF PETS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Snail & Slug Bait-M is very effective for the control of snails and slugs on lawn and turf areas, in flower gardens, in ornamental ground covers and in greenhouses. The bait should be applied to soil around ornamental plants but not directly on plant foliage. Do not use on or around plants used for food.

Do not enter treated areas for 24 hours after application unless protective clothing is worn.


Flower Gardens, Ground Covers, Landscape Plantings, Greenhouses: Spread bait uniformly over area to be treated at the rate of 1 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. For best results, lightly water area to be treated before application. Special attention should be given to treating areas around flower beds, around building foundations and under greenhouse benches.

To avoid damage to your garden, start applying when snails and slugs first appear at the beginning of the spring planting season. Repeat as needed to keep areas free of snails and slugs.

Lawns and Turf Areas: Distribute bait evenly over lawn area at the rate of 1 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. Brush lightly with broom or leaf rake to shake bait off of lawn surface to soil. Water lightly after application.

NOTE: Snails and slugs are most active at night and when conditions are warm and moist. Treatment after watering, in late afternoon or evening will often improve control.
