

Copper Spot, Dollar Spot: As a preventative—use 4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. Begin before diseases appear. Repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals. As a curative or under severe conditions favoring development of disease use 6 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. Apply at 7 day intervals.

Snow Mold (Oregon & Washington only): As a preventative or curative use 6 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. Apply in the fall. Repeat at 7 to 14 day intervals as necessary.

Stem Rust of B.Jegrass: As a preventative—use 4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. Begin before disease appears. Repeat at 7 to 14 day intervals. As a curative or under severe conditions—use 6 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.
