DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use this product to control moss on turf/lawns, base of trees (trunks) and landscape areas that has moss growing on a surface for which staining is not a concern. Avoid contact with concrete or any building structures as the product will cause permanent staining. Wash off sidewalks, driveways and painted surfaces, from overspray, after application to minimize staining of concrete and other hard surfaces.

Prior to application, prepare the application site by raking lawn lightly to remove leaves, dead grass and other debris. Then mow lawn to expose moss and to allow No Mas to penetrate the turf canopy.

<u>Mixing:</u> Prior to adding No Mas to the spray tank, add an acidifier adjuvant to the spray solution water. Then add No Mas to half of the water, then agitate and add the remaining water.

Application: For broadcast application, use ground-driven sprayers and apply No Mas at 50-75 lbs. in 130-220 gallons of water per acre (18.5-27.75 oz. [dry weight] in 3-5 gallons of water per 1000 ft²). For spot treatment or small areas, use a hand pump or backpack sprayer at 1 lb. of No Mas per 2-3 gallons of water for each 125 ft² to be treated. For optimal results, two applications spaced 2-3 months apart, are recommended per growing season. Always apply No Mas uniformly. Best results are typically achieved when No Mas is applied with a hand spray gun. To avoid injury to surrounding turf areas, No Mas should be applied when temperatures are cool (40-75°F) during the winter and spring months. If warmer temperatures (75°F or higher) are expected, No Mas needs to be watered-in immediately after application to remove the active ingredient from turfgrass leaf surfaces. Rinse spray equipment with water thoroughly after application.
