
2. Submit five (5) copies of final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
Use 1 1/2 oz. per-100 lbs. of fabric in the final rinse after soap. For best results dilute dosage in 1-2 gallons of water and then add to final rinse before softener and run for a minimum of 4 minutes.
Bio-Rinse G is a special treatment to be used as an adjunct to standard laundering routine. It is not intended as a terminal disinfectant for fabric or hard surfaces at the concentrations recommended.

Do not reuse empty drum. Return to drum reconditioner or rinse well with soap solution and discard. Do not contaminate water by disposal of waste.

WHEN USED AS DIRECTED

Bio-Rinse G imparts a self-sanitizing residual to the fabric that reduces the number of Staph. E. coli, B. ammoniagenes and many other harmful organisms under conditions of high humidity or wet contamination.

Bio Rinse G imparts a bacteriostatic residual to the fabric that will inhibit the growth of antibiotic resistant staph and enteric coliform organisms under conditions of high humidity or wet contamination.

Bio-Rinse G helps reduce the danger of cross infection due to contaminated linen.

Bio-Rinse G inhibits the growth of bacteria which produce ammonia in diapers.

DANGER

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
