

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If product gets in eyes, flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician. In case of skin contact, wash thoroughly with soap and water. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If product is swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, or public waters unless in accordance with an NPDES permit. For guidance, contact the regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

DIRECTIONS FOR

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FREMONT 9114 MICROBIOCIDE is used to control algae and bacteria in commercial and industrial recirculating and industrial, nonpotable water supply systems. It should not be used for drinking or food preparation. Before treatment with **FREMONT 9114** is begun, cooling water systems should be cleaned of scale and deposits. Then they should be drained, refilled with water, and treated with a dose of 2.5 to 10.0 fluid ounces of **FREMONT 9114** per 1000 gallons of water in the system. Repeat until a total dose of 10.0 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water every 10 days to prevent the growth of algae and bacteria in industrial water systems. Use 10.0 fluid ounces of **FREMONT 9114 MICROBIOCIDE** per 1000 gallons of water entering the system if continuous use is needed.
