PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes and lips. Do not spray directly on face.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE. Do not use or store near fire, sparks, or heated surfaces. Turn off pilot lights in gas appliances and vapors or turn off electrical equipment in the use area. After airing out phase is completed, relight pilot lights and reconnect electrical current. Do not smoke in the use area. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Incineration of container may cause explosion.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For skin application to protect against mosquitoes, biting flies, gnats and fleas: Hold unit 4 to 6 inches from the skin of arms or legs while applying with a slow sweeping motion until surface is slightly moistened. Run with hand to insure even distribution. To apply to face and neck, spray in palm of hand in short bursts and spread on the skin. **AVOID CONTACT WITH EYES AND LIPS. DO NOT SPRAY DIRECTLY ON FACE. DO NOT USE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME.**

For clothing treatments to protect against biting insects, chiggers, (mites), and ticks: Treat shirt, trousers, and socks by holding unit 6 to 8 inches from the clothing while applying with a slow sweeping motion. Continue operation until surface is slightly moistened; saturation is not necessary. For mosquitoes and other biting flies, liberal application should be made where bites occur, such as across the shoulders and along the thighs. For ticks and chiggers, liberal applications should be made along all openings of clothing, such as inside the neck band, and the fly and cuffs of trousers and tops of socks. A thorough application requires 3 to 4 ounces of material or 3 to 4 minutes spraying time. Against mosquitoes, biting flies, fleas, and chiggers, one application is effective for a week if repellent is not washed away, and against ticks for 3 to 4 days. Clothing may be treated several days before wearing. If irritation develops, discontinue wearing treated clothing.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If in Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water for 15 minutes. Seek medical aid.

If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry place, away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not store at temperatures over 130°F.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
