Subject: Label Revision in Response to PR Notice 91-4
Chem Spray Bug Ban Insect Repellent Spray
EPA Reg. No. 7056-20
Submission: October 31, 1991

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1) Delete the phrase "for the whole family" from the statement "Bug Ban Insect Repellent Spray provides hours of protection for the whole family from mosquitoes and biting flies."
- 2) Delete the following statements from the product label as these are inconsistent with the provisions of PR Notice 91-4:

A thorough application requires three to four ounces of material or three to four minutes of spraying time. Against mosquitoes, biting flies, fleas, mites, and chiggers, one application is effective for a week if repellent is not washed away. It is also effective against ticks for three to four days.

This aerosol spray allows you to hold the can and spray at an angle . . . even upside down . . . to cover ankles, legs, even your back.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

HAZARDS TO HUMANS-CAUTION: For external use only. Do not get in eyes or mouth. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist or using in enclosed areas. Avoid contact with lips. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, irritated or excessively sunburned skin. Do not expose treated skin or clothing to fire, sparks or flame until liquid has evaporated. Do not spray directly on face.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS: EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE. Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near fire, sparks or heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water & induce vomiting or rub the back of throat with finger. DO NOT induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN: May cause skin reactions in rare cases. If so, wash with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.

READ ALL DIRECTIONS BEFORE USING THIS PRODUCT.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Hold unit 4 to 6 inches from skin or clothing while spraying, keeping nozzle pointed away from face. Slightly moisten skin or clothing with a slow sweeping motion. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary. Apply on face by first spraying small amounts in palm of hand and spreading on face and neck. Do not apply to the hands of young children. Do not apply on skin under clothing. Wash treated skin after returning indoors. Will not damage cotton, denim, wool, nylon or Orlon. Do not apply on or near synthetic fabrics such as Rayon, Spandex or Dynel, leather, plastic watch crystals and painted or varnished surfaces. Wash treated clothing after use.

For clothing treatments to protect against mosquitoes, biting insects, chiggers, (mites), and ticks a thorough application should be made where bites occur. A thorough application requires three to four ounces of material or three to four minutes of spraying time. Against mosquitoes, biting flies, fleas, mites, and chiggers; one application is effective for a week. Excellent if not washed away. It is also effective against ticks for three to four days.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place, away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not store at temperatures over 130°F.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Place container and contents in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.
