Dear Mr. Spears:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Three copies of the finished labeling must be submitted to the Agency prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the product label is enclosed for your records.

- a. Change the phrase "Hazards to Humans" to read "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals."
- b. Under the **Precautionary Statements**, change the sentence "May be harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin" to read "Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin."
- c. Under the **Directions for Use**,
 1. Add the phrase "with soap and water" to the sentence "Wash treated skin after returning indoors."
 2. Add the following statements: "Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you."

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS

CAUTION

For external use only. Do not spray directly on face. Do not get in eyes or mouth. May be harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist or using in enclosed areas. Avoid contact with lips. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, irritated or excessively sunburned skin. Do not expose treated skin or clothing to fire, sparks, or flame until liquid has evaporated.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE. Contents under pressure. Keep away from fire, sparks, and heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause container to burst.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ ALL DIRECTIONS BEFORE USING THIS PRODUCT.

Hold container four to six inches from skin or clothing and spray in a slow sweeping motion, keeping nozzle pointed away from face. Apply until skin or clothing is slightly moist. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary. For facial application, spray small amount in palm of hand and spread on face and neck. Do not apply to the hands of young children. Do not apply to skin under clothing. Wash treated skin after returning indoors. Will not damage cotton, denim, wool, nylon, or Orlon. Do not apply to or near synthetic fabrics such as rayon, spandex or Dynel, leather, plastic watch crystals, and painted or varnished surfaces. Wash treated clothing after use.

For clothing treatments to protect against mosquitoes, biting insects, chiggers, mites, and ticks, a thorough application should be made where bites occur.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Keep in locked storage area. Store in a cool dry place, away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not store at temperatures over 130°F.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Replace cap and discard in accordance with all local, state, and federal laws and regulations. Reduce pollution at its source.
