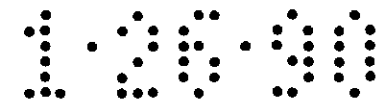

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For use in homes, bakeries, food plants, restaurants, schools, hotels, motels, office buildings, hospitals, and food handling plants.

Remove protective cap, hold container upright and point valve in desired direction and press button to spray.

FOR HOUSE FLIES, MOSQUITOES, AND GRATS: Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward, direct the spray to all parts of the room especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

WASPS: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

FOR CRAWLING INSECTS: Roaches, earwigs, grain mites, sow bugs, spiders, and centipedes: spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards, and storage areas. Spray directly on insects when possible. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: Spray trails, nest and point of entry. Spray on ants when possible. Repeat as necessary.

SPIDERS, CENTIPEDES, SOW BUGS, CRICKETS: Spray directly on webs and places where these pests crawl. Spray directly on insects when possible.

CARPET BEETLES, MOTHS LARVAE: Clean and air contaminated materials before treating. Spray directly on pests, repeating treatment as needed. Articles not stored in mothtight container should be retreated every 30 days.

BEDBUGS: Spray cracks and surfaces in baseboards, floors, moulding, and other contaminated areas. Take bed apart and treat mattress, springs and frame.

FLEAS: Spray floors, floor coverings, cracks, bedding, sleeping quarters, and other areas frequented by pets. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray pets.

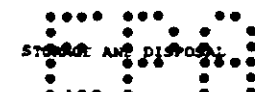
