DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Remove cap, shake well, and press button to release foam. Apply a strip of foam down the back, extending from the neck area approximately one inch from the base of the tail. The foam will penetrate the hair, breaking down gradually to produce an effective back line coverage.

This treatment will control fleas on cats, dogs, puppies and kittens. Repeat treatment if necessary, but not more than once a week.

Do not allow foam to get in eyes or on scrotum.

Do not use on pregnant animals.

Do not use on lactating animals.

Do not use on animals that are still nursing.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS CAUTION

Do not contaminate feed, water or foodstuffs. Keep out of reach of children. Wash hands after use.

Avoid contact with skin. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing of vapor.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF ON SKIN: In case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water for 15 minutes. Call a physician.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Use and Store Above 50°F

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F. may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.
