DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Hook flea tag to dog's collar and pinch "S" hook together. Flea kill begins at once and will continue for 3 months while the tag is worn. Ticks are harder to kill, but those in neck area only will be killed for a short period after the tag is attached. For continuous protection, replace tag every 3 months. For dogs over 50 lbs. use two tags.

CAUTION

Do not open protective pouch until ready to use. Do not allow children to play with tag. Tag is intended for use only as an insecticide generator. (Shed's U.S. Patents 2,950,073 and 3,116,201) and is not to be taken internally by man or animals. Do not use on sick or convalescing dogs. Do not use on cats, whippers, or greyhounds. Do not use other preparations on dogs while tag is worn. Remove the tag if any adverse reactions are observed. Some animals may be sensitive to this product.
