DIRECTIONS FOR USE

CHEM SPRAY WASP AND HORNET SPRAY combines several effective insecticides into a specially effective insecticides into a specially designed package to control wasps and hornets from a distance of 6 to 8 feet

Remove protective cap. Hold spray container upright, point spout of nozzle toward nest, crevice or hold where insects are and press center of valve top and spray desired area for three to five seconds. This will wet the nest and kill nesting insects. Be sure entire nest and all insects are contacted by spray.

The jet stream action allows you to stand 6 to 8 feet away from the nest, giving you reasonable safety in killing wasps, hornets, bees, yellow jackets, and spiders.

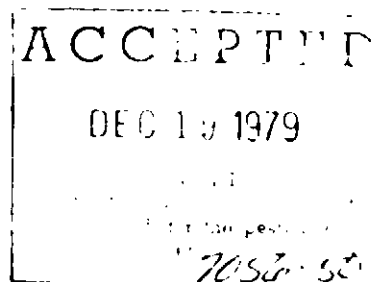
PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
